Dragon Corner Bookmark Instructions.

You will need - 2 large red squares of paper (roughly 21 x 21cm) a small red piece of paper (approx 10 x 10cm) & a mini white piece of paper (approx 5 x 5cm).

Take one large square and fold in half diagonally.

Take the bottom right corner and fold up to the top corner.

Repeat on the left hand side.

Unfold and fold the top corner of the top layer of paper to the bottom, where the 2 diagonal folds meet.

Take the right hand corner and fold to meet the middle, where the top corner was also folded to in step 5.

Repeat step 6 on the left hand side.

Lift the bottom right hand side up and hook the fold created in step 6 over the fold created in step 5.

Repeat on the left hand side.

Take the top corner and tuck the whole of the top sec tion behind the halfway fold as well, crease in place once in postion.

Take a pen and mark on nostrils close to the bottom of the triangle, and some lines across the middle to suggest wrinkles on the dragon.

Take your small piece of red paper & cut small triangles from the corners.

Glue the triangles to the top of the dragon's head to create horns.

Cut small semi circles out from the mini white piece of paper and stick to the face to create eyes. Using a pen to add detail to the eyes .

Repeat steps 2 - 4 on the second large square.

Take the left hand side and fold diagonally from the bottom corner to about 2cm away from the fold you've just created.

Repeat the same angle of fold on the right hand side.

Fold the left edge in line with the fold created in step 16, and repeat on the right to the fold from step 17.

Repeat the process again, about 2cm away from the previous diagonal folds.

Gently pull both sides out, these are your dragon's wings.

Take the top layer of paper from the top corner and fold down to where the wings meet.

Draw a tail on your small red piece of paper, including a triangle for the tip of the tail.

Cut the tail out and glue to the underside of the top point.

Slot the central triangle from your second large square inside the pocket of the dragon's head, until it's fully tucked in.

Your bookmark is completed. Slot the corner of the page you're holding inside the pocket behind your dragon's head & let the dragon guard your page!
