The series includes: 2 table centrepieces, 2 tree ornaments, 1 mask, 3 mini presents and 2 party hats, with instructions on how to construct each one.

#6 Mini Presents



#6 Mini Presents **instructions**

- 1 Cut out all parts. Use a craft knife for best results.
- 2. Carefully fold along all fold lines (see key). Before folding it is recommended to score the line lightly with a craft knife or a ballpoint pen that no longer has ink in it. This will make folding easier and more precise.
- 3. Take part 1 and glue the tabs to their corresponding sides (ie. tab 1A to side 1A) until you have a closed box.
- 4. Take one of the part 2 strips and glue the middle accross the centre of the top side of the box, ensuring that the printed side is face up. Continue gluing the strip all the way round until it meets at the bottom. Repeat this with the other strip, forming a ribbon cross over the box.
- 5. Take parts 3 and place them back to back so that both sides are the printed sides. Bend the ends around to meet in the middle. Then glue the two together like this with the ends glued in the middle. This will be the bow.
- 6. Take part 4 and wrap around the join of the bow and glue the ends underneath.
- 7. Now take parts 5 and, putting glue on the marked areas, fix them underneath the bow at a right angle to the direction of the bow loops. Now glue the complete bow on top of the present.
- 8. Repeat the same actions for the other two presents. Take note that on the remaining two presents, the ribbons will be different lengths to match the lengths of the sides. Be sure to match the right ribbon length to the side before sticking.
